The objects contained in the corporation's Letters Patent dated March 31 1980; as amended by Supplementary Letters Patent dated January 4, 1994; as further amended by Supplementary Letters Patent dated August 13, 2020 are deleted in their entirety and replaced with the following:

The purposes of the corporation are:

1) To provide a public amenity by establishing, maintaining, and operating an archive, a library, or a museum space for the public, and to advance education by developing exhibits and programs to be offered as educational aids on topics relating to LGBTQ2+ people and history.

2) To advance education by providing workshops, classes, seminars, conferences, training programs and educational resources on subjects relating to LGBTQ2+ people and history to the public.

3) To advance education by conducting and/or funding research on subjects relating to LGBTQ2+ people and history and disseminating the research results to the public.

4) To receive and maintain a fund or funds and to apply all or part of the principal and income therefrom, from time to time, to charitable organizations that are also registered charities under the Income Tax Act (Canada) and/or to the following qualified donees under the Income Tax Act (Canada): registered national arts service organizations, municipalities in Canada, municipal or public bodies performing a function of government, and the Government of Canada, a province, or a territory.

All the provisions contained in the corporation's Letters Patent dated March 31 1980; as amended by Supplementary Letters Patent dated January 4, 1994; as further amended by Supplementary Letters Patent dated August 13, 2020 are deleted in their entirety and replaced with the following:

The special provisions are:

a. Commercial purposes, if any, included in the articles are intended only to advance or support one or more of the non-profit purposes of the corporation. No part of a corporation's profits or of its property or accretions to the value of the property may be distributed, directly or indirectly, to a member, a director or an officer of the corporation except in furtherance of its activities.

b. The corporation shall be subject to the Charities Accounting Act.

c. No director shall receive remuneration for services provided in the capacity as a director, although they may be paid reasonable expenses incurred by them in the performance of their duties. Unless otherwise prohibited by the corporation, a director may be compensated for services other than as a director pursuant to the regulation made under the Charities Accounting Act, or with court approval or an order made under section 13 of the Charities Accounting Act.

d. To invest the funds of the corporation pursuant to the Trustee Act.

e. Upon the dissolution of the corporation and after satisfying the interests of its creditors in all its debts, obligations and liabilities, its remaining property shall be distributed to a Canadian body corporate that is a registered charity under the Income Tax Act (Canada) with similar purposes to its own, the Crown in right of Ontario, the Crown in right of Canada, an agent of either of those Crowns or a municipality in Canada.

f. The corporation shall be carried on without the purpose of gain for its members, and any profits or other accretions to the corporation shall be used in furtherance of its purposes.

g. The corporation is authorized to establish one class of members. Each member shall be entitled to receive notice of, attend and vote at all meetings of the members of the corporation.

h. The board of directors of the corporation may not make, amend or repeal any by-laws that regulate the activities or affairs of the corporation without having the by-law, amendment or repeal confirmed by the members by special resolution. The by-law, amendment or repeal will be effective from the date of the adoption of the special resolution by the members of the corporation.

i. All funds and other property held by the corporation immediately before the articles become effective or that are received subsequently by the corporation pursuant to any will, deed or other instrument made before the articles become effective, together with any income or other accretions to the funds or other property, will be applied only to the purposes of the corporation as they were immediately before the articles become effective.
